



Webinar on the NSF Graduate Research Fellowship Program (GRFP)

Are you a CUNY Graduate Student in a Science or Engineering Discipline?

Are you interested in receiving financial support for your education?



The National Science Foundation's GRFP can provide you with a fellowship which includes three years of financial support including an annual stipend of \$34,000 and a cost of education allowance of \$12,000 to your institution

To be eligible for the NSF GRFP, you must:

1. Be a US citizen, US national, or permanent resident
2. Intend to pursue a research-based Master's or Ph.D. program in a GRFP-supported field
3. Be enrolled in an eligible program at CUNY ([See Appendix of NSF GRFP solicitation for eligible programs](#))
4. Be at an early stage in your graduate career
5. Have completed no more than one academic year of full-time graduate study

Graduate students are limited to only one application to the GRFP, submitted either in the first year or in the second year of graduate school
